1.	Letter of Invitation, Organizational Conflicts of Interest, page 3; RFQ IV. FORM OF STATEMENT OF QUALIFICATIONS, J. Conflict of Interest, page 9	The Conflicts of Interest provision is revised, in part, as follows: The following contractors are not eligible to submit SOQs as prime consultants: (1) any firm that develops or sells <i>has sold or installed</i> software for tolling-collecting tolls systems in the United States ; such firms also may not participate as a subconsultant in an SOQ; or (2) any firm that operates the Bay Area FasTrak® Customer Service Center as the prime contractor or sub-contractor. <i>The firm and any of its subconsultants that are selected under this contract are explicitly prohibited from bidding on and providing any services that are specified by requests for proposals developed under this contract.</i>
2.	Proposers’ Conference and Submitted Questions and Answers, August 21, 2012, Answer No. 6	A6: While no specific format is required, please include information regarding positions, with corresponding descriptions and hourly rates, and types and amounts of anticipated expenses. Rates should be fully loaded hourly rates. Note that Addendum No 1 requires that the Price Proposal be submitted separate in a sealed envelope.

The remaining provisions of the RFQ, dated August 1, 2012, remain unchanged. In the event of a conflict between this Addendum and the previous version(s), this Addendum takes precedence.

MTC will issue a second set of Questions and Answers, and any addenda if necessary, responding to requests for exceptions or changes to MTC's standard contract terms, including insurance requirements.
