Questions & Answers:
From Bidders' Conference held on October 31, 2012 and
Clarifications/Exceptions received by November 2, 2012

- Q1: Does MTC SAFE have an Engineer's estimate for this project?
A1: The Engineer's estimate is \$815,000.
- Q2: Who will be responsible for conducting inspections, Caltrans or MTC SAFE?
A2: Field inspections will be conducted by a Caltrans Project Engineer.
- Q3: What is the established Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) goal?
A3: The DBE goal is 3.2% of the Total Bid Price. See Addendum #1.
- Q4: When is the work expected to be completed?
A4: MTC SAFE requests that all work be completed by the end of February 2013 before the contract end date. However, all work must be completed by June 30, 2013.
- Q5: What happens in the event that the Contractor has completed work conforming to the Plans and Specifications, but the ramp meters do not turn on due to a major problem not caused by the Contractor?
A5: Depending on the issue, the cost to rectify, as well as the availability of funds, the issuance of a task order to rectify the situation will be considered.
