QUESTION & ANSWER DOCUMENT

Q1: Does MTC require that all development be done in the United States?

A1: No.

Q2: We have found Kentico Content Management System (CMS) to be more user-friendly to non-programmers than Drupal. We understand that Drupal is your preferred CMS, but we would like to know how willing your organization would be to switch (especially since we offer training)?

A2: The new MTC website will be powered by Drupal. MTC intends to launch the Vital Signs website prior to the release of the new Drupal-based MTC website. Therefore, the initial launch of the Vital Signs website will be hosted on a different server than the Drupal-based site. However, Vital Signs will need to be seamlessly integrated within the Drupal-based MTC website in the future; thus, the Vital Signs site should be designed in a way to support the move to the new Drupal-based website
