This assessment shall rely heavily on existing, current research and shall outline how the existing and emerging technologies could be applied to the Bay Area's freight network. The assessment shall include recommendations of where within the goods movement system the various strategies could be the most effective at reducing emissions. Each assessment shall also include a feasibility analysis of two applications of zero and near zero emissions technologies Each technical assessment memo (3A below) shall include a feasibility analysis for applications of the technical strategies that will inform the potential demonstration project implementation plans. This analyses will inform the Action Plan.
